1. **What is the MMS programme offered at Kohinoor Business School?**

The MMS (Master of Management Studies) is a 2-year full-time postgraduate degree in management. It combines strong academic foundations with practical exposure across Finance, Marketing, HR, Operations, and Systems to prepare students for corporate careers.

2. Is the MMS degree at KBS recognized?

Yes. The MMS programme is affiliated with the University of Mumbai, approved by AICTE, and governed under the Directorate of Technical Education (DTE), Maharashtra.

3. What is the difference between MMS and PGDM?

MMS is a university-awarded degree, while PGDM is a diploma offered by autonomous institutes. MMS follows the University of Mumbai curriculum and examination pattern.

4. What specialisations are available in MMS at KBS?

5. Who is eligible to apply for MMS at KBS?

Graduates with a minimum of 50% marks (45% for reserved categories in Maharashtra) from a recognised university are eligible.

6. Which entrance exams are accepted for MMS admission?

Scores from MAH-MBA CET, CAT, CMAT, MAT, XAT, and ATMA are accepted as per DTE norms.

7. What is the admission process for MMS?

- Appear for an accepted entrance exam.
 - Participate in the DTE Centralised Admission Process (CAP).
 - Select Kohinoor Business School during option filling.
 - Complete document verification and fee payment upon allotment.

8. What CET percentile is typically required for MMS at KBS ?

The required percentile varies each year based on CAP rounds and seat availability. Candidates are advised to check recent cut-offs during the admission cycle.

9. How many seats are available for MMS at KBS?

The MMS intake is approximately 120 seats per academic year.
